PROJECT APPROVAL REQUEST

The membership was requested to approve the funding of \$1200 for a cement pad extension to the Rifle Range. After a lengthy discussion with regards to the specifications, cost accuracy, and project priority, the membership approved a motion to forward request back to committee for specification, cost, and Board review. Membership rejected a request for \$3900 required to add concrete barriers to the creek bed. In accordance with Club By-Laws, all expenditures in excess of \$1000 require membership approval.

DOG TRAINING RULE & REGULATIONS

1. All persons to have on hunters' orange at all Times.
2. Birds must be tagged before release.
3. Tagged birds must be logged onto sign in sheet and checked off upon being killed or taken from ARGC.
4. All non members are to pay \$20.00 per day/per man and must be accompanied by a club member.
5. All persons utilizing fields must have membership card in possession at all times.
6. Training grounds are on a put and take basis only, you must release birds to use the facility, if 3 birds are released then only 3 birds may be taken not 4.
7. Trainer must sign in before entering field and sign out upon exiting.
8. No more than 3 firearms with live ammunition are to be used.
9. Hours are from sunrise to sunset.
10. You must obtain lock information from preserve or dog training chairman at a cost of \$5.00 before using field.
