### BY - LAWS CHANGE

It is proposed that the By - Laws, Article V11 Initiation and Dues, 3rd. Paragraph; "A working member must also furnish eight (8) hours of work to the club, by October 31 of each year" be changed to read "A working member must also furnish eight (8) hours of work to the club, by December 31 of each year." Work hours performed in November and December of 2012 will be allowed to carry over to 2013. This is a one time exception! Membership will be asked to approve this change at the January 2013 Membership meeting.

### WORK TIME CARD

A new document for submitting work time hours was presented and unanimously approved by the membership during the November meeting. Effective January 1, 2013 all working members will be issued a wallet size card for logging their hours, date, work performed, and approval signature. The completed card will be submitted with payment of annual dues. The individual card replaces the log sheets that were posted outside the clubhouse. The documentation of hours and signature approval process does not change.
