Letter from the Vice President

To: All ARGC Members

Subject: Major Improvements and accomplishments for 2017

The Officers and Trustees have worked hard and will continue to work hard to make our club the best. Please see the quick summary of some of the major changes for 2017.

#1 - Rifle Range Improvements. We have recently added electricity/lighting to the rifle range.

#2 - Clubhouse Heating. We changed our heating at the clubhouse from electric to propane. The estimated savings per year is \$2,000.00.

#3 - Trap and Skeet Field. We replaced the concrete and added gravel on the fields.

#4 - Land Assessment Restructuring. To ensure all members pay their fair share in land assessments just as current members have. This should also generate approximately \$7,000 per year to go to the land fund or if emergencies happen.

#5 - Junior Membership. We created a junior membership program to provide our younger members (18-20) an opportunity to join the club and waiving land assessment fees until they are 21 years old.
