

### **2019 ARGC WORK TIME DUTIES**

The following is a list of duties that are always available and are an ongoing process here at ARGC. Starting in late April and lasting through till late October. Most of the duties listed below are general suggestions.

### LAWN MOWING

-Specifically around the pond, front entrance, septic fields, skeet/trap houses, CMP house & pavilion. (using your own mower is OK).

### WEED EATING

-If it looks like it needs it please do it. The ditch along the driveway is easily an 8 hour card signing, If you want to be in charge of maintaining this, call me.

### CULVERT/DITCH DEBRIS REMOVAL

-Culverts that drain water get clogged with leaves. Please clean regularly if you decide this job is for you.

### FIREWOOD CUT, SPLIT & STACK FOR THE 2018/2019 SKEET/TRAP SEASON

-Probably the most needed work time for the year. Call me for details.

### FLOWER BEDS WEEDING AND MULCHING

-For the entire season this needs done. Weeding, turning over mulch and general maintenance of the beds. Its minimal, but gets your card signed.

### BRANCHES/STICKS REMOVAL

-Another all year work time duty. We all know when the winds blow. The burn pile is located south of the Madden House.

### **GUTTER CLEANING**

-All buildings need gutters cleaned in the spring and fall.

### ROAD MAINENTANCE

- -If someone wants to tackle trimming of the trees to 12 feet to allow road to dry and allow vehicles with campers to pass.
- -If you are in charge of this, please maintain throughout the year for specific events.

### BIRD PRESERVE

-Weed eat around stand and buildings. Round up all areas weed eated.

### PISTOL/RIFLE RANGE


-Weed eat, round up around buildings/targets, mow. Attend events needing help. BURN PILE

-Please do on an appropriate day.

Notify me immediately if any problems so we can get it fixed.

### KYL (Know Your Limits) .22 LR

Eight round hanging steel targets ranging in diameter from 2" down to 1/4" shot at 50 yards from a bench or prone. Front bipod and/or bag and a rear bag may be used.

Live matches may be viewed on YouTube.

### 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the month. April through October.

Sign-up and sight-in 9:00 AM. Match starts at 10:00 AM.

### Match:


- Range Fee for the KYL Match \$5.00 (\$4.00 Members-\$3.00 Juniors < 18)</li>
- Shoot the Match for bragging rights or.... enter the Money Match (\$5.00)
  - o Five rounds are shot in the Match
  - Target point assignment: 2-2-3-4-6-8-10-15 = 50 possible points per round
  - Acquire and bank points for each hit target. A miss or out of order hit loses all points for the round.
  - o All Money Match dollars will be paid out to top 3 places (50/30/20)

### Rules:

- Shooting position from bench or prone
- 50-yard targets
- 8 shots in one 2-minute round
- Visible target movement must be evident to score a hit. A high arm hit is a miss. The Scorer's decision is final. All contestants are urged to participate in scoring.
- 22 LR only. No Stingers, Magnums, or .17 caliber
- No rifle or scope restrictions
- Front bipod and/or bag and rear bag are allowed
- No adjustable or one-piece rests. No lead sleds.
- No rear monopods or mechanical rear support devices
- No tripod configuration fixtures
- Eye and ear protection required.
- An Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) must be installed when not at the bench.
- Ties will be broken by a shoot off using the smallest target scored
